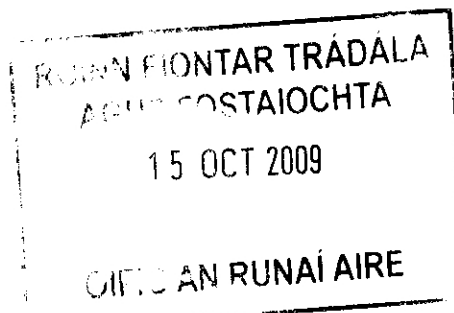
Dear Tánaiste,

I refer to your correspondence dated August 2009 to Mr Willie Penrose TD, Chairman of the Joint Committee on Enterprise, Trade and Employment concerning 'Public Consultation in relation to the introduction of a Code of Practice for Grocery Goods Undertakings'.
