I, Tony Killeen, Minister of State at the Department of Enterprise, Trade and Employment, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by sections 28 of the Safety, Health and Welfare at Work Act 1989 (No. 7 of 1989) and the Labour (Transfer of Departmental Administration and Ministerial Functions) Order 1993 (S.I. No. 18 of 1993) (as adapted by the Enterprise and Employment (Alteration of Name of Department and Title of Minister) Order 1997 (S.I. No. 305 of 1997)) and the Enterprise, Trade and Employment (Delegation of Ministerial Functions) Order 2004 (S.I. No. 809 of 2004) and, after consultation with the National Authority for Occupational Safety and Health, hereby make the following regulations:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Safety, Health and Welfare at Work (General Application) (Revocation) Regulations, 2005.

2. These Regulations shall come into operation on 31 August 2005.

3. The provisions of the Safety, Health and Welfare at Work (General Application) Regulations 1993 (S.I. No. 44 of 1993) mentioned in *column (1)* of the Schedule to these Regulations are revoked to the extent specified in *column (2)* of that Schedule.

4. The Safety, Health and Welfare at Work (General Application) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations 2003 (S.I. No. 53 of 2003) are revoked.
