Meat Industry Ireland (MII) is the Ibec sector association responsible for representation of the business interests of the beef and lamb processing sector in Ireland. MII is a major sector division within Food and Drink Industry Ireland (FDII). MII member companies are responsible for approximately 85% of total beef and lamb processing and exports in Ireland.

MII welcomes the Government's commitment to introduce and enforce statutory regulations in the grocery sector. These regulations are essential to redress the power imbalance between retailers and suppliers. This will ensure that retailers' commercial success is purely dependent on meeting consumer demand efficiently. This will benefit all stakeholders operating in the domestic grocery sector including the consumer.

In this context, FDII has made a major submission in response to this consultation process. As the association representing the business interests of the beef and lamb processing sectors in Ireland, MII fully support this FDII position.
